ישעיהו ו' א' - ג' Isaiah 6:1-3

(א) בשנת־מות המלך עזיָהוּ וְאַרְאַה אֶת־אֱלֹהֵי יֹשֵׁב עַל־כִּסֵּא רָם וְנִשְׂא וְשׁוּלְיוֹ מְלֵאִים אֶת־הַהֵיכָל: (1) In the year that King Uzziah died, I beheld God seated on a high and lofty throne; and the skirts of God's robe filled the Temple.

(ב) שְׂרָפִים עֹמְדִים | מִמַּעַל לִּי נִשְׂא כְּנָפַיִם לְאָחָד | יְכַסֶּה פָּנָיו | וּבִשְׁתַּיִם יְעוֹפֵף: (2) Seraphs stood in attendance on God. Each of them had six wings: with two he covered his face, with two he covered his legs, and with two he would fly.

(ג) וְקָרָא זֶה אֶל־זֶה וְאָמַר קְדוֹשׁ | קְדוֹשׁ קְדוֹשׁ | הִנֵּה צְבָאוֹת מְלֵא כָּל־הָאָרֶץ כְּבוֹדוֹ: (3) And one would call to the other, "Holy, holy, holy! Adonai of Hosts! God's presence fills all the earth!"
