

Exodus שמות 25

א 1 The Eternal One spoke to Moses, saying:

ב 2 Tell the Israelite people to bring Me gifts;
 ויקחו־לי תְּרוּמָה you shall accept gifts for Me from every

ו 6 oil for lighting, spices for the anointing oil

ז 7 lapis lazuli and other stones for setting, for

ח 8 And let them make Me a sanctuary that I

ט 9 Exactly as I show you—the pattern of the

י 10 They shall make an ark of acacia wood,
 וַעֲשׂוּ אֲרוֹן עֵצֵי שִׁטִּים two and a half cubits long, a cubit and a half

יא 11 Overlay it with pure gold—overlay it

יב 12 Cast four gold rings for it, to be attached to its four feet, two rings on one of its side walls and two on the other.

יג 13 Make poles of acacia wood and overlay them with gold;

יד 14 then insert the poles into the rings on the side walls of the ark, for carrying the ark.

טו 15 The poles shall remain in the rings of the ark: they shall not be removed from it.

טז 16 And deposit in the Ark [the tablets of] the Pact which I will give you.

יז 17 You shall make a cover of pure gold, two and a half cubits long and a cubit and a half wide.

יח 18 Make two cherubim of gold—make them of hammered work—at the two ends of the cover.

יט 19 Make one cherub at one end and the other cherub at the other end; of one piece with the cover shall you make the cherubim at its two ends.'

כ 20 The cherubim shall have their wings spread out above, shielding the cover with their wings. They shall confront each other, the faces of the cherubim being turned toward the cover.
