Eternal, whose trust is the Eternal alone.

waters, sending forth its roots by a
stream: it does not sense the coming of
heat, its leaves are ever fresh; it has no
care in a year of drought, it does not cease
to yield fruit.

the mind—to repay every person
according to their ways, with the proper
fruit of their deeds.

it will leave him, and in the end, he will

old, Our Sacred Shrine!

forsake You shall be put to shame, those
in the land who turn from You shall be
doomed, for they have forsaken the
Eternal, the fount of living waters.
