**Leviticus ויקרא 19:1-14**

- א וַיְדַבֵּר יְהוָה אֶל־מֹשֶׁה לֵאמֹר:** 1 The Eternal One spoke to Moses, saying:
- ב דַּבֵּר אֶל־כָּל־עֲדַת בְּנֵי־יִשְׂרָאֵל וְאָמַרְתָּ אֲלֵהֶם קְדוֹשִׁים תִּהְיוּ כִּי קָדוֹשׁ אֲנִי יְהוָה אֱלֹהֵיכֶם:** 2 Speak to the whole Israelite community and say to them:  
You shall be holy, for I, the Eternal your God, am holy.
